

SUPPLY LIST FOR FRIDAY WORKSHOP

Greetings Quilters!

If you have never “string pieced” before, this is an excellent introduction for you to try this method of quilting!

I warn you, it IS addicting!

You will need the following:

Working sewing machine, foot pedal, full bobbin, thread, and extension cord. “Strings” in the colors you wish to work in for your string star. I used Kaffe Fasset in 6 color families for mine.

If you do not have strings, bring scraps in the color you wish to work in and we will make some strings.

Various scraps in various sizes for your background, enough to make a 32” square. I used a navy background for my sample.

Tone on tone fabrics work the best in my opinion for the background, or 1 piece of fabric 32” square.

If you can come to the workshop with your background already made, it would be helpful. I highly recommend a hodge-podge pieced background as it adds more interest to the finished piece.

1 yard of steam-a seam fusible (please choose your own weight to use). I used a lighter weight. This amount is more than enough!

I will provide a paper template for your diamond shapes. I will also provide the telephone book pages for foundation piecing.

Scissors and rotary cutter. If you have a small cutting mat, this would be helpful, but not mandatory.

6”by 12” ruler or other small ruler.

One can of heavy spray starch. Or Best Press.

To complete wall hanging you will need:

1 yard of backing fabric

38” square of batting

For a scrappy binding; use enough 2.5” strips in various lengths to make 135” of binding or for 1 fabric ; cut 4 2.5” width of fabric and make into binding.
