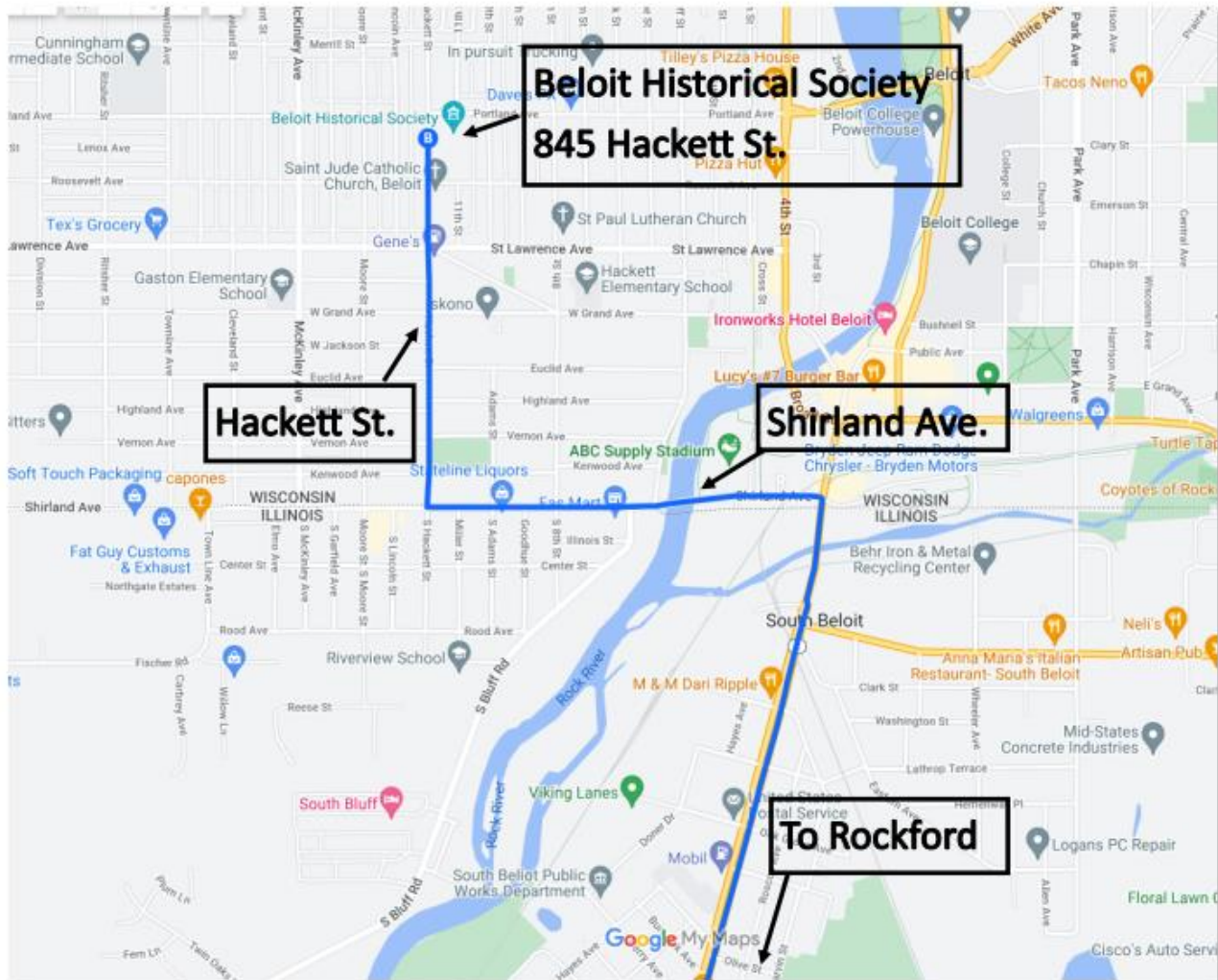
If you want to bring table decorations that's fine but, please, no open flames and no glitter.

Directions to Beloit Historical Society, 845 Hackett St. Beloit

Go north on Main St. (Hwy 2) to Beloit

Turn left on Shirland Ave. (Just across the IL/Wi border) Go 3/4 mile.

Turn right on Hackett St. Go 3/4 mile.

Arrive at Beloit Historical Society on the right.

NOTE: If you live on the east side of Rockford it is still easier to travel west on Auburn St. or Riverside and take N. Main St. To Beloit.
